

# Spartans to compete in NCAA East Regional Track Meet

After helping Michigan State to seventh place finishes in the Men's and Women's Big Ten Outdoor Track and Field Championships earlier this month, Kyron Foster, Shane Wells, Erica Mann and Charlise Davis are among the record 26 Spartans competing in the NCAA East Regional at Greensboro, N.C. Runners must have posted a time ranked 49 or better in the region during the season.

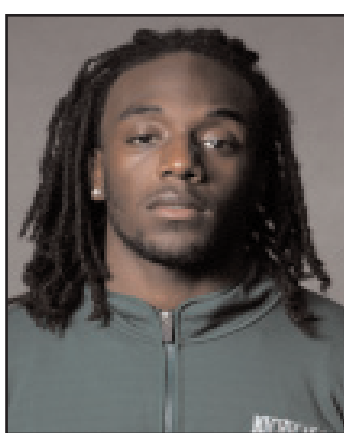
MSU, and he will have to surpass his school record performance of 16.21m if he is to reach his goal.

Wells, a junior from Romulus who finished third in the 110m high hurdles at the Big Ten championships this season, will compete in that event. He finished third in the Big Ten meet with a time of 14.36 after placing second in the 60 meter hurdles indoors.

Mann and Davis are among the MSU women for the second year also. Davis placed second in the 200 meter dash at the Big Ten outdoor meet, and fifth in the 100. She will compete in both events as well a run a leg of the 4x100 meter relay on a

Foster, an indoor All-American who won both the indoor and outdoor Big Ten championship in the triple-jump this season, leads the MSU contingent. He hopes to improve upon his 15th place national finish as a sophomore last year.

Foster has improved his leap by five feet since coming to

Mann will also compete in the open 100 and 200 as well as the relay. Mann finished fourth in 100 and sixth in the 200 at the Big Ten meet.



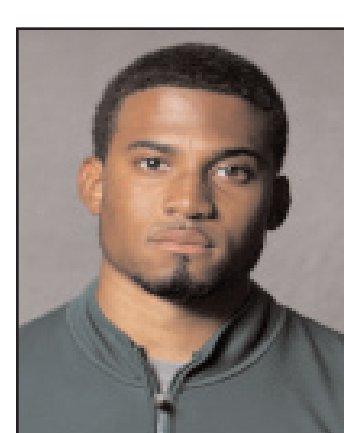
